Last year 30,000 plus attendees were at the event, and over \$50,000 was raised for local charities. In order for this event to be a hit, we need the help of neighboring organizations to volunteer their time on Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. The event takes place at Tempe Beach Park – 80 W. Rio Salado Parkway.

We have many **paid** volunteer opportunities for local, non profit organizations and incentives to take advantage of. Primarily there is one shift of 5 hours from 4:30-9:30 p.m. We will do everything possible to try and make sure you get the position you volunteer for, however an overflow in one area may lead to you getting your second choice or even your third. Every volunteer will receive a commemorative t-shirt, one meal ticket and 2 tickets to the event for family or friends. Volunteer hours will be recorded and donations will be made to the **non-profit organization** they are representing. Those 18 years old and up will receive \$10/hr and mature 13-17 year olds will receive \$5/hr. 13-17 year olds must have adult supervision. It's a great opportunity to help the community and raise money for your organization.
